

## **Golf Division Terms and Conditions**

### **Dress Code & Etiquette**

- The Rules of Golf and The Belfry Golf Course Etiquette must be adhered to at all times on the golf courses and putting green – this document is displayed at Golf Reception and with the Starter.
- No denim/jeans are allowed. Trousers or tailored shorts only to be worn (no combat style trousers or shorts allowed) and **all** shirts must have a collar or a mock neck and must be worn tucked in (no round neck T-Shirts permitted) – short socks are permitted with shorts.
- Golf shoes only are permitted on The Brabazon, PGA National and Derby golf courses – spiked shoes are **not** allowed in any part of the resort with the exception of the Golf Centre including Sam's clubhouse. Soft spikes can be worn throughout the resort.
- Pitch marks must be repaired, divots replaced and bunkers raked.
- Anyone acting in a dangerous or disruptive manner or not following The Belfry Golf Course Etiquette may be asked to leave the golf course, driving range or putting green and no refund can be made.

### **Tee Times**

- Golfers to be on their starting tee 10 minutes before their allotted tee time.
- All golfers are expected to play from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee, unless otherwise instructed.
- The Belfry reserves the right to amend any tee time.
- The Belfry reserves the right to make all groups into four balls.

### **Golf Bag Storage**

- Golfs bags are not permitted in the hotel public areas or bedrooms, so we do ask that you make full use of this facility or alternatively store bags in cars until needed

### **Buggies and Trolleys**

- The hire of golf buggies and pull trolleys is sold in good faith at the time of making a reservation.
- The Belfry reserves the right to restrict / ban the use of golf buggies and trolleys, in accordance with weather conditions prevailing at the time. Exemption from this can only be granted on production of a valid Doctor's certificate. (In extreme weather conditions, a total ban will be enforced).

### **Weather Conditions**

#### **Rain**

- In the event of adverse weather conditions, play will be halted if, in the opinion of The Belfry Golf Team the golf course is unfit for play.

#### **Fog**

- *Pre Play:* If the water fountain on the 9<sup>th</sup> / 18<sup>th</sup> lake is not visible from the PGA National Starter's hut, golfers cannot be allowed on the course.
- *Players on the course:* A horn will be sounded 3 times to advise golfers to return to the Golf Centre.
- Play will only start/re-start when the fountain is visible.
- The Golf Duty Manager, together with the Head Green Keeper will make the final decision.

#### **Frost**

- In the event of frost, any decision will be made by the Head Green keeper.

#### **Snow**

- In the event of snow, any decision will be made by the Head Green keeper

### **Play Delayed or Cancelled due to adverse Weather Conditions**

**Acceptable/Non Acceptable Dress Code**

**NOT ACCEPTABLE**

- Football shirts or tracksuits
- Shirts pulled outside of trousers
- Sports shorts, beach shorts, blue denim trousers or cargo shorts
- Trousers tucked into socks or shorts with long socks rolled down
- Training shoes

PLEASE DISPLAY YOUR BAG TAG AT ALL TIMES



**ACCEPTABLE**

- Men's shirts must have a collar and sleeves (turtle/rollneck acceptable)
- Shirts tucked inside trousers
- Tailored shorts or long trousers
- Long or short socks may be worn with shorts
- Golf shoes - preferably with soft spikes
- Golfing headwear to be worn correctly

IF YOU ARE NOT PROPERLY DRESSED YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE COURSE

The Rules of Golf and The Belfry Golf Course Etiquette must be adhered to at all times on the golf courses and the hotel putting green and full details are available upon request. Soft spikes may be worn throughout the resort. Pitch marks must be repaired, divots replaced and bunkers raked. Anyone acting in a dangerous or disruptive manner or not following The Belfry Golf Course Etiquette will be asked to leave the golf course, driving range or putting greens and no refund can be made. Every player to use only his/her own set of golf clubs. Mobile 'phones are allowed on course but must be used with respect for other golfers and not affect the pace of play
